What is Rave New World?

Rave New World is a spectacular new outdoor show. A Luton story told through lyrics, music, amazing aerial, cars (yep, real cars on stage) and Tangled Feet's trademark physicality which will leave audiences in a place to party! Created in partnership with Revoluton and Luton's infamous Exodus Collective, this collaboration delves into Luton's rebellious rave music heritage and asks: what can the DIY free party movement of the 80s and 90s offer us today as we face local and global challenges in 2025.

Who Can Apply?

Anyone with a Luton postcode over the age of 16. We will give priority to those living within 1 km of the performance location at Marsh House. We are looking to recruit people from a range of ages and backgrounds, and actively encourage those new to performing to get involved! All the movement will be accessible choreography (designed with the needs of all participants in mind).

What will you get out of it?

- Learn new skills: Gain experience in movement, choreography, and ensemble work, even if you have no prior experience.
- Local: Gain a unique experience right here in the heart of your community.
